

NNDA Event Attendance Policy Effective July 1, 2008

NNDA sponsored events provide a valuable networking and educational opportunity for members. Non-members are allowed an opportunity to attend the events, but are encouraged to join NNDA in order to experience the full range of benefits NNDA provides.

Currently, corporate and platinum members are encouraged to bring other staff persons within their organization to NNDA events. Professional members attend as members of NNDA; however, their membership level does not extend to others within their company.

In order to recognize our members, but to also give non-members an opportunity to learn more about NNDA and the benefits of membership, the following event pricing policy is hereby adopted:

NNDA Breakfast and/or Luncheon Meeting Price Structure

(subject to change without notice)

- Ø Cost of admittance will be \$50 per person

- Ø NNDA members will be given a discounted rate as follows:
 - o \$30 at the door
 - o \$20 with advance registration

NOTE:

- o Professional members will be provided the discounted member rate as stated above
 - o Other personnel of Professional members will be charged the cost of admittance
 - o All employees of Corporate members will be allowed to attend at the discounted member rate as stated above

- Ø Members and non-members registering to attend the breakfast meeting will be asked to RSVP and pay on-line or will be billed in advance of the event

 - Ø Members and non-members that are ~~not~~ ~~shows~~ will be required to pay the full admittance price of \$50

 - Ø NNDA reserves the right to set alternative pricing for breakfast, luncheon or dinner meeting/events at its sole discretion.

Member Only Events

- Ø These events are not open to the general public. Only members in good standing may attend, thus only the ~~member~~ ~~price~~ will be published. Prospective members will be allowed to attend with the approval of the Executive Director or Member Services Manager.
